

Youth in Twentieth-Century Czechoslovakia

The thematic focus of the 2013 Collegium Carolinum annual conference (7-10 November) is youth. The interdisciplinary conference will examine young people's realm of experience, the history of youth organisations and youth cultures, and educational and child-rearing concepts on the territory of the former Czechoslovakia.

We welcome proposals for papers in the fields of history, European ethnology/ethnography, pedagogy, and other disciplines on the following themes:

- The role of young people in the national movement/nationality struggles
- Youth organisations and movements
- Youth culture(s) and young people's realm of experience
- Education and educational institutions, youth welfare
- Educational and child-rearing concepts

The conference will cover the period from 1898 to 1989. Particular attention will therefore be devoted to the lived experiences of young people under the dictatorships of the twentieth century and the interrelationship of state-supported and unofficial youth cultures and youth lifestyles.
